

Securing Our Families and Communities

- Passed legislation to double round-the-clock tracking of sex offenders with ankle bracelets and preventing them from going into “exclusion zones,” such as school grounds.
- Provided free ComputerCOP software, allowing parents to scan children’s computers for threats.
- Co-sponsored ban on sale to minors of cough medicines that include Dextromethorphan (DXM).

Leadership With Real Results

Tax Relief and Government Reform

- Helped cut general fund taxes leading to a three-year tax freeze.
- Tax exemptions for active duty military personnel.
- Voluntarily cut staff payroll.
- Supported reform of community grants to ensure grants are transparent and serve worthy causes.

Enforcing Immigration Laws

- Supported law requiring businesses doing work with the County to verify the legal status of employees.
- Supports Police Department’s policy to arrest those caught driving without a license.
- Called on police to enforce laws that prevent solicitation of work in traffic.
- Opposed to government hiring halls.

Improving Our Quality of Life

- Helped stop expansion of the Iroquois Pipeline, which would have exposed residents to hazardous conditions.
- Preserved more than 100 acres of land within the district.
- Worked to establish dog run areas at county parks.
- Obtained funding for projects to help revitalize Main Street in Smithtown.
- Joined with civic associations and community members to remedy groundwater flooding.
